Open Mustang & Burro Show

Rules & Important Info: Please read every point before asking questions. Thank you! Check in starts Thursday morning at 7am at the green Race Horse Barn. Must sign a liability release to compete. Must be paid in full at check in to compete.

NO DOGS ALLOWED ON FACILITY PER HORSE EXPO RULES.

- Stall assignments will be posted at exhibitor entrance.
- All patterns will be posted Friday afternoon at check-in stall in green Race Horse Barn.

DIVISIONS

Division Key: JY - Junior Youth (ages <12), Y- Youth (ages 13-17), I – In-Hand, B – Burro, WT – Walk/Trot, WTL – Walk, Trot, Lope, S– Speed.

- There are no cross entering same rider/equine into In-Hand, WT or WTL divisions.
 - Speed Division – In-Hand can go any gait, speed wins. Walk/Trot – can walk or trot but must not break to lope/canter (10 seconds added for every gait break). Walk/Trot/Lope – can go any gait, speed wins.
 - JY (Junior Youth) & Y (Youth) may cross enter into the following divisions: In-Hand, Walk/Trot, Walk/Trot/Lope or Speed. They will be eligible to win all highpoints their classes entered qualify for plus the JY and Y highpoints.
 - Same equine may only be used for no more than two separate divisions.
 - TIP Challenge horses, over 3yrs, broke to ride may compete in the Open Show in ridden divisions.
 - The more classes you enter, the bigger chance you have to WIN highpoint buckles and prizes!
- All animals being ridden must be a minimum of 3yrs old.
- Large classes of 15 or more may be split per show host discretion. Classes of 3 or less may be canceled per show host discretion.
- Rider/handler may wear Western or English clothing and tack in any class.
- Youth 17yrs and under must wear a helmet when riding.
- All classes are \$20 each. If signed up and paid for prior to May 1st, divisions are flat rate each, see google sign up form for pricing on flat rate early bird sign up price. Sign up here: <https://forms.gle/vPXMkgbvTHGBh65V9>
- Ribbons to 6th place in each class (unless class has greater than 12 participants, than ribbons to 10th place).
- High Point Ribbon and High Point Buckle and \$200 to High Point Divisions Champion PLUS Reserve High Point Ribbon and \$100 to Reserve High Point Division Champion. – Junior Youth, Youth, Burro, In-Hand, Walk/Trot, Walk/Trot/Lope and Speed.
- Placings announced at end of each class and ribbons passed out. Monies paid out and highpoint awards at end of show on Sunday.
- Stalls & Tack Stalls booked through google sign up form only and payable to show host. Stalls are \$90 for the entire weekend (Thursday through Sunday - equestrian center sets the price, not us), there is no per day fee. No tying at trailer, every animal must have a stall (Horse Expo rule). May arrive as early as Thursday morning at 7AM (If traveling far and would like to arrive Wednesday evening please get preapproval from Amber).
- SHAVINGS & RV RENTALS/SPOTS – all shavings orders and renting of RV spaces and RVs must go through Murieta Equestrian Center. Link to contact them here: <https://murietaequestriancenter.com/exhibitor-information/> or call (916) 985-7334.

Class List and Descriptions

Saturday, June 10, 2023 - Start time approx. 3pm after TIP Challenge awards (eligible divisions for each class in parentheses). Division Key: JY – Junior Youth, Y - Youth, I - In-Hand, B - Burro, WT – Walk/Trot, WTL - Walk/Trot/Lope, S – Speed

1. **Costume** – dress up you and your equine and wow the crowd (JY, Y, I, B, WT, WTL)
2. **Lead Line Showmanship** – handler with rider (any rider, any age or stuffed toy works too for animals under 3yrs or not broke to ride, pack saddles may be used on burros and mules) to complete showmanship pattern. Judged based on degree of difficulty and showmanship. Points go towards highpoint for both handler and rider (JY, Y, I, B, WT, WTL)
3. **In-Hand/Burro Barrel Racing** – fastest time of clover leaf pattern (pattern smaller than ridden pattern) (JY, Y, I, B, S)
4. **Walk/Trot Barrel Racing** – fastest time of clover leaf pattern – may not break into canter, gait break add 10 seconds per break (JY, Y, WT, S)
5. **Barrel Racing** – fastest time of clover leaf pattern, any gait (JY, Y, WTL, S)
6. **In-Hand/Burro Speed Barrels** – fastest time of speed barrel pattern (JY, Y, I, B, S)
7. **Walt/Trot Speed Barrels** – fastest time of speed barrel pattern – may not break into canter, gait break add 10 seconds per break (JY, Y, WT, S)
8. **Speed Barrels** – fastest time of speed barrel pattern, any gait (JY, Y, WTL, S)
9. **In-Hand/Burro Pole Bending** – fastest time any gait (smaller pattern than ridden) (JY, Y, I, B, S)
10. **Walk/Trot Pole Bending** – fastest time – may not break into canter, gait break add 10 seconds per break (JY, Y, WT, S)
11. **Pole Bending** – fastest time any gait (JY, Y, WTL, S).
12. **In-Hand/Burro Keyhole** – fastest time any gait, run down into key hole, turn around, and run back (JY, Y, I, B, S)
13. **Walk/Trot Keyhole** - fastest time, may not break into canter, gait break add 10 seconds per break. Run down into key hole, turn around, and run back, (JY, Y, WT, S)
14. **Keyhole** - fastest time any gait, run down into key hole, turn around, and run back. (JY, Y, WTL, S).

Sunday, June 11, 2023 - Start time 9am - Arena A

15. **Burro Halter** – halter class just for burros (JY, Y, B)
16. **Mustang Halter** – halter class just for mustangs (JY, Y, I, WT, WTL)
17. **Showmanship** – handler and equine will complete showmanship pattern (JY, Y, I, B, WT, WTL)
18. **Walk/Trot Equitation** – Under saddle rail class where rider is judged on their equitation, (JY, Y, WT).
19. **Walk/Trot Pleasure** – Under saddle rail class where equine is judged primarily (JY, Y, WT)
20. **Walk/Trot Discipline Rail** – Simon says rail class (JY, Y, WT)
21. **Walk/Trot Ranch Riding** – ranch riding pattern (JY, Y, WT)
22. **Walk/Trot Hunter Hack** – two small cross rails set up with pattern, must maintain trot (JY, Y, WT)
23. **Walk/Trot/Lope Pleasure** – Under saddle rail class where equine is judged primarily (JY, Y, WTL)
24. **Walk/Trot/Lope Equitation** – Under Saddle rail class where rider is judged on equitation (JY, Y, WTL)
25. **Walk/Trot/Lope Discipline Rail** – Simon says rail class (JY, Y, WTL)
26. **Walk/Trot/Lope Ranch Riding** – ranch riding pattern (JY, Y, WTL)
27. **Walk/Trot/Lope Hunter Hack** – two small cross rails set up with pattern (JY, Y, WTL)
Lunch Break (1 hour)
28. **In-Hand/Burro Discipline Rail** – Simon says rail class (JY, Y, I, B)
29. **Puissance** – there will one jump that will get raised until no one can make it over! Starting height 2'. (JY, Y, I, B)

Arena B – Open (may do class at anytime, just tell judge which class you are in)

30. **Ground Driving** – ground drive a pattern over and through poles & obstacles (great exposure to trail obstacles 😊) (JY, Y, I, B, WT, WTL).
31. **Burro Trail** – simple trail course in-hand, may be ridden or in-hand (JY, Y, B)
32. **In-Hand Trail** – trail course for in-hand horses only (no burros) (JY, Y, I)
33. **Walk/Trot Trail** – trail course for WT equines only (JY, Y, WT)
34. **Walt/Trot/Lope Trail** – trail course for WTL equines only (JY, Y, WTL)
